



COLYFORD ROAD SAFETY

In preparation to forming our own **Colyford Village Council**, your **Residents Association**, along with the **Steering Group** and the **Colyford Speedwatch Team**, have acted in advance of the **Community Governance Review** by working with, and being fully supported by, your **County Councillor** to enhance our Colyford road safety. Although at the 'submission' stage, this is a major step forward towards future traffic management plans for Colyford.

Key points:

- An application has now been submitted to Devon County Council to reduce the speed limit along the A3052 to 20mph, from Gully Shoot to Cownhayne Lane, also to be extended along the Seaton Road beyond the Wetlands entrance/Popes Lane.
- The Coly Road, B3161 Colyford towards Colyton, will have the speed limit reduced from 40mph to 30mph.
- New signage and road markings are also included in the submission.
